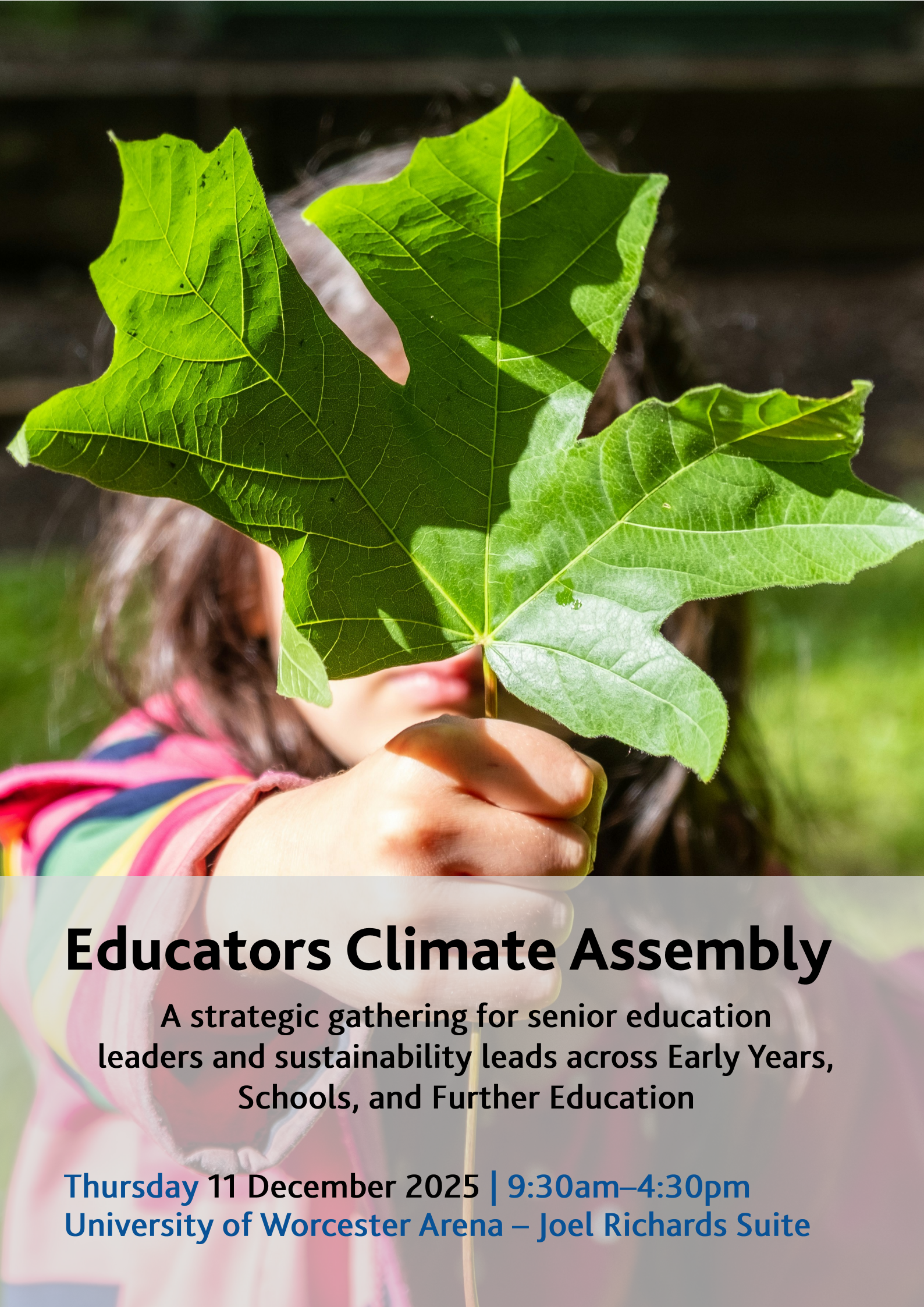

Why now?

By the end of this year, the Department for Education expects all schools to appoint a Sustainability Lead and begin developing a Climate Action Plan. This assembly offers a timely, sector-wide opportunity to connect, collaborate, and prepare.

Schools can ensure that their safeguarding policies and practices account for the growing risks posed by climate change. Reflective audits can support education settings in identifying vulnerabilities—such as extreme weather impacts, air quality issues, and climate-related mental health concerns—and to embed resilience measures into safeguarding frameworks. By doing so, schools can protect student welfare and maintain safe learning environments in the face of climate-related challenges.
- ⇒ Support with the **practicalities of Climate Action Plans**.
- ⇒ Exploration of the **psychological impacts** of the climate and ecological emergency on staff and students.
- ⇒ **Modelled activities and takeaways** to use in your setting — from understanding young people's emotional needs to climate sharing circles.
- ⇒ Insights from the **National Emergency Briefing** with key updates from specialists in:
 - National security
 - Energy
 - Food security
 - Health
 - Economics
 - Extreme weather
